CLIMATE CONDITIONS Climate conditions for winter and spring 2001 were normal. Budding took place early followed by optimal flowering and water controlled stress, producing good concentration. The summer was warmer than usual. The harvest was characterized by a complete absence of rain, allowing the winemaker to harvest as appropriate. These conditions contributed to a sterling year highlighted by exceptional aromas, mature tannins, terrific balance, concentration and colour.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES Beautiful colour, dense with lovely garnet red notes. The nose is open and warm, with notes of smoke and hints of hot spices. Swirled in the glass, notes of stewed red fruits and red currants are underpinned by a deeper aroma of vanilla and cigar box. Mouth feel is full bodied and develops to a pleasant intensity with a fresh finish on the palate. Notes of minerals and toast combine with elegant fruit, revealing a chic and distinctive wine.
